AT EACH CHURCH OR CHAPEL VISITED

- Get a steward (if available) to sign Section B on the front of this form.
- If the building is not open or is unmanned, record its name, the time and 'Not open', then continue.
- Your visit counts even if the building is not open.

- RIDE IN SINGLE FILE, NOT IN LARGE GROUPS.
- OBSERVE THE CYCLING SECTION IN THE HIGHWAY CODE.
- WALK WHEREVER CYCLING IS DIFFICULT OR DANGEROUS.
